At Elangeni College there are excellent training opportunities to enter the Hospitality and Tourism sector. The following Tourism and Hospitality programmes offered at Pinetown Campus, are accredited by CATHSSETA (Culture, Arts, Tourism, Hospitality and Sport Sector Education and Training Authority).

The Certificate in General Travel (NQF 5) includes various industry-related short-courses, including Galileo; Payment Procedures; Travel Agency Operations; Fares within Africa; and ICDL (4 modules).

Programme requirements:

Certificate in Professional Cookery (NQF 4) / Food and Beverage Services (NQF 4):

- Matric certificate/NQF level 4 qualification/Grade 12 or equivalent pass
- Good written and spoken communication skills.
- Good posture and prepared to work long hours in the kitchen/restaurant
- Computer literacy is an added advantage
- An interest in the Hospitality industry

Certificate in General Travel (NQF 5)

- Matric certificate/NQF level 4/Grade 12 or equivalent pass
- Good written and spoken communication skills.
- Computer Literacy is an added advantage
- An interest in the Travel and Tourism industry

The above courses have an exit level at the end of the year, but the student may re-enrol for the Diploma Level of each course. To qualify for the Diploma Level, the following must have been achieved in the previous year: All credits for the Certificate Level must have been completed and the student deemed competent. All relevant Certificate Level in-service training must have been completed. Programmes are subject to student numbers.

General Information:

All the above Certificate & Diploma courses follow the OBE system and are National Qualifications. In-service training for each level contributes to approximately 20 - 40 credits per programme and has to be completed before any certification is to be expected. Students are expected to do additional research and must have the ability to use the internet.

For the Hospitality courses: The correct tool kit and uniforms have to be used by the student (the cost of which is included in the fees). Over and above lectures,
